#### Originality

All submissions must be original work created by you. The use of Al, and plagiarism, the act of using someone else's work without proper attribution, is strictly prohibited. This includes copying and pasting text from other sources, paraphrasing without acknowledgment, and failing to cite sources appropriately. We use plagiarism and Al/ChatGPT detection tools to ensure the integrity of our content. If you use quotes or reference other works in your article, please include a link to the source near the relevant detail so that we can add a hyperlink in your article.

Example: "In a historic milestone, Arkansas reported zero abortions in the year 2023. www.healthy.arkansas.gov/images/uploads/pdf/Induced\_Abortion\_2023\_vital\_stat.pdf"

Originality not only ensures the credibility and quality of our platform but also upholds the trust of our community.
